Dear Parents/ Guardians of CHS Students,

This letter is to inform you that Clinton High School will be on early release schedule for exam week (Jan. 14th through Jan. 18th). All EOC, NC Final Exams, and CTE Exams will be administered during the last five days of the fall semester. Please pay close attention to the differing times for Early Release as this is different from previous exam schedules. Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday CHS will dismiss at 2:00 pm and on Thursday and Friday dismissal will be at 1:00 pm. A mandatory review block has been scheduled for Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of Exam Week. All students are expected to attend the review sessions even if they do not have an exam scheduled for that specific day. Students that do not have a scheduled exam should arrive at 11:45 for the review sessions for the next days exam.
